FORT BEND COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 7**


Notice is hereby given that **FORT BEND COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 7** will hold a meeting on **August 24, 2020, 10:00 a.m.** at **Quality Life Ministries, 4647 FM 521, Fresno, Texas 77545.**

The District will consider and act upon the following matters:

1. Call meeting to order and opening prayer.
2. To receive public comment.
3. Presentation of deed for fire station property by County Commissioner Vincent Morales, and any necessary action on same.
4. Review and take action regarding property recently received from MUD 23.
5. Conduct the public hearing/open forum to allow interested parties to address the Board of Commissioners and be heard regarding the proposed property tax rate setting.
6. Conclude Public Hearing on Tax Increase.
7. To adopt the District 2021 budget.
8. To adopt the 2020 District tax rate for maintenance and operations.
9. To adopt the 2020 District tax rate for debt.
10. To review and take action on matters related to construction, renovations, repairs and improvements to District facilities and real property, including engagement of design professional(s) or engineering firm(s) and cooperation with Fort Bend County EMS regarding the development of stations to include housing EMS units.
11. To review and take action to approve the Minutes of prior meetings.
12. To act on financial matters, including financial report, invoices/bills, investments, Investment Policy, financial institutions, credit cards, required reports, and revisions to budget(s).
13. To review and take action to amend the District 2020 budget.
14. To review and take action on District website and community outreach matters.
15. To receive a report from the Fire Chief and Command Staff regarding Fresno Fire & Rescue operations and activities, to review requests from Fire Department on operational expenses.
16. To review and take action on the District's strategic plan, including presentation by committee.
17. To review and take action on acquisition of capital equipment and vehicles.
18. To review and take action on matters related to COVID-19, including but not limited to meeting procedures, emergency expenditures and continuity of operations per Government Code §418.1101.

19. To review and take action to address ISO/PPC classification ratings and its effect on the District and its residents.
20. To meet in Closed Session pursuant to Govt. Code §551.071 to consult with legal counsel on litigation, settlements or confidential matters under Texas Bar Rules.
21. To meet in Closed Session pursuant to Govt. Code §551.072 regarding real estate matters.
22. To meet in Closed Session pursuant to Govt. Code §551.074 to discuss personnel matters.
23. To review and take action on personnel matters, including District Command Staff, including action regarding compensation, benefits, job duties, schedule, hiring, policies and retention.
24. To act on real estate, including sales, purchases, leases, permits, encumbrances, platting, surveying and utilities.
25. To review and take action on matters related to the provision of emergency services and territorial jurisdiction in areas of the District near Missouri City and certain water districts.
26. To discuss future agenda items and set the September 2020 meeting date.
